I am writing on behalf of more than 1.2 million members of the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) to thank you for taking leadership to complete America's streets by sponsoring the Complete Streets Act of 2009. This legislation complements state and local efforts across the country and is vital to making our streets accessible and welcoming to all of our citizens regardless of age, ability, or chosen mode of transportation.
