Dear Senator DeMint:

The National Association of REALTORS® strongly opposes Senate Amendment 4710 to the flood insurance bill being debated by the Senate. On behalf of the more than 1.2 million members of the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR), I urge you to reconsider offering Senate Amendment 4710 for the following two reasons.

First, raising insurance costs on houses at a time of decreasing housing values would have a negative effect on housing affordability. Second, this amendment, if enacted, would result in neighboring properties facing identical flooding risk paying significantly different premiums.
