



CONFIDENCE BAROMETER SHOWS SLIGHT UPTICK




SOCIETAL CONCERNS LEVEL OFF; REMAIN ABOVE PERSONAL




CONTEXT: RESPONDENTS ACTIVELY ENGAGE

Percent who have participated in this activity in the past 12 months




INCREASING NUMBERS ARE READY TO GO / RECENTLY ACTIVE





How much more likely would you be to do each of the following, if everyone received a rapid COVID-19 test prior to being allowed to engage in the activity, and only those negative were allowed to do so?




1/3 THINK WE'LL BE LESS FOCUSED ON COVID BY YEAR'S END




DESPERATELY SEEKING SOCIAL INTERACTIONS

- Labor Day weekend familiar outings on a much smaller scale than typical
- Even small social interactions give promise of normalcy
 - "I had a fair amount of just random interactions with people...we were still social distancing, but it felt much more normal than looking at strangers like 'stay away from me.'"
- First thing they want to do after pandemic: Any activity with friends or family
 - Ex. gathering, dinner, game night, hugging, shaking hands, meeting people
- Hurricanes, wildfires, and September snow add to their stress

Return to travel, getting out


















THEY ARE STILL LOOKING IN LESS-DENSE AREAS

As you re-enter the home buying market, how, if at all, are you expecting your search location to change?




MANY ARE SHIFTING SIZABLE SUMS TO HOME IMPROVEMENT

During 2020, how much money do you expect to shift away from travel and leisure spending, and redirect it towards making home improvements?




1/4 ARE CONSIDERING A SECOND HOME

During the pandemic have you seriously considered, or started looking at, purchasing a second home?




MANY ARE THINKING ABOUT REMODELING, OR HAVE ALREADY

During the pandemic have you spent money or contemplated spending money on remodeling your residence?




FURNITURE AND PAINTING ARE TOP REMODELING SPENDS

How are you contemplating spending money on remodeling? (Check all that apply)








NEARLY HALF RELOCATE IN THE WINTER

During most winters, do you typically relocate at least part of the time from a cold weather climate to a warm weather climate?




WINTER RELOCATION MEANS STAYING WITH FAMILY


During most winters, how do you typically relocate at least part of the time from a cold weather climate to a warm weather climate? (Check all that apply)



MOST WHO TYPICALLY RELOCATE PLAN TO DO SO AGAIN


