Dear Administrator Criswell,

On behalf of 1.5 million members, thank you for the opportunity to meet in person with FEMA Assistant Administrator Jeff Jackson at NAR's 2024 NXT conference in Boston, MA. Over two days, Mr. Jackson briefed thousands of real estate leaders on flood insurance issues across nearly a dozen member committees, regional vice president meetings, a "hot topics" roundtable, a newsmaker interview, and numerous smaller meetings. The member feedback was uniformly positive. Even the members facing the most poignant flood challenges walked away with a new appreciation of the tough job FEMA must do with limited resources while responding to major disasters, closing the flood insurance gap, and building a more resilient nation for the future.

Mr. Jackson's meeting coincided with FEMA and NAR's renewal of our Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to collaborate and contribute to public awareness about the importance of flood resiliency and insurance. Most notably, that agreement outlines our commitment to:

- Meeting regularly and sharing information about our mutual efforts to educate the nation and sharpen outreach, communications, and messaging to help consumers make informed decisions;
- Reviewing, strengthening, and co-branding educational materials and resources for property owners and buyers, including a comprehensive toolkit on disaster preparedness; and
- Collaborating on ways to more effectively disseminate this information using our combined communications channels and social media networks.


